2016-2017 Budget Review

Budget hearings will be held on June 2 and June 7 from 9AM-5PM in City Hall. You can find the complete schedule in my May Newsletter, which is posted on my website matthaag.com. The budget proposes both a tax cut and increased spending and I'm anxious to see how the budget will accomplish both of these goals while balancing fiscal responsibility and maintaining our current level of support for City services. Following the City budget process, the joint public hearing for the Rochester Central School District budget will be held on June 8 from 5:30 to 6:30 in City Council Chambers.
