Historic Subway and Aqueduct Task Force

Back in February, there was a proposal to create a promenade along Erie Harbor to connect the Genesee Riverway trail. There were many people in the community who voiced concerns over the project. I held the legislation and promised to form a Task Force with all the relevant stakeholders in the community. I'm happy to announce the Task Force will have its first two meetings in July.

This group is tasked with creating feasible ideas and plans for current and future access points in the historic aqueduct. Additionally, the group should take in to consideration the larger issue of use of this historic, cultural amenity within our city that may be implemented now or in the future. It is important that decisions reached in the present will not preclude bright ideas for the area in the future.

There will be a series of events throughout the week including the Pride Games, movies, comedy shows, and other events.
